**Appointment of New CEO & Superintendent**

Carolyn Rogers has been appointed the new CEO of the Financial Institutions Commission (effective June 11, 2010). She has also been appointed Superintendent of Financial Institutions, Superintendent of Pensions, Superintendent of Real Estate, Registrar of Mortgage Brokers and CEO of the Credit Union Deposit Insurance Corporation of British Columbia.

Most recently, Carolyn served as the Assistant Deputy Minister at the BC Public Service Agency, Client Services. Prior to that, she spent most of her career in the financial services industry. Carolyn started at the Royal Bank where she worked in retail banking and investments and then went on to the credit union system where she spent time at the provincial centrals in both Saskatchewan and Alberta. Carolyn has a MBA from Queen's University and is a CMA.
